The primary investment objective of the Fund is to obtain steady growth and maximum stability for capital invested. The portfolio will strive to provide investors with a minimum return in excess of inflation (CPI+3%) over a rolling 5 year period.

Investment features

The underlying collective investments will have specific targets to achieve and to provide investors with a level of capital protection. This portfolio will achieve this through the underlying collective investments using various asset classes to deliver inflation adjusted returns. Some of the underlying collective investments will have the option of using derivative instruments to protect the portfolio against negative equity market movements. The other asset classes that will be included are fixed income, money market

Performance fees

Performance fees are absolute return based, which implies that performance fees are only accrued on positive performances above an adjusted inflation target

Fund performance fees

Absolute based performance fee - 20 % of outperformance of CPI+3% (Capped at 2%)

Performance fees of 0.64% (Class A) and 0.63% (Class B) were levied on the fund due to outperformance of the benchmark.

Total expense ratio (TER)

A Total Expense Ratio (TER) is a measure of a portfolio's assets that are relinquished as operating expenses. The total operating expenses are expressed as a percentage of the average value of the portfolio. Included in the TER is the proportion of costs that are incurred by the performance component, fee at target, trading costs (including brokerage, VAT, STT, STRATE and insider trading levy) and other expenses. These are disclosed separately as percentages of the net asset value. A higher TER ratio does not necessarily imply a poor return, nor does a low TER imply a good return. The current TER cannot be regarded as an indication of future TERs. The total TER* was therefore 2.83% (Class A) and 2.25% (Class B).



Investment manager weighting (%)




Asset class exposure - effective (including derivatives) (%)
